Help is needed in a wide variety of ministries, including teaching English, theological training, sports ministry and more. As you read and learn more about the Asian Pacific Rim Peoples, prayerfully consider how God might be calling you to help further the spread of the gospel among them.





Pray for the missionaries' children to grow strong in the Lord. As their parents serve others, pray these children will also love the people they live among and will find ways to serve with their parents.







Description:

This Cluster or Team training will be a crucial time for missionaries and missionary leaders from the Asia-Pacific Rim to gather for strategic training. Many of these missionary leaders lead not only an IMB missionary team, but also influence a broader network of national and international partners for the sake of multiplying evangelism, discipleship, and church planting efforts among millions of people. This is a much-needed time of equipping, encouraging and planning. Your willingness to help support the families during this time is key to making this possible. We would like a group of adult volunteers who would be able to plan a VBS / summer camp type experience for a group of missionary kids for a one-week period. Time will be given as well for these volunteers to travel and learn more about this important capital city in the Asia-Pacific Rim.

Currently, we do not have a breakdown of ages or numbers of children. As planning begins, we will have more details and can better determine the number of adults that will be needed. Likely, an average of 6 to 8 adults will be needed to help with this childcare / VBS type program.

Pray for strong relationships to develop between various SBC churches and field teams. As churches intercede and have hands-on opportunities, pray they will see the value of the time they have invested as lives are changed, believers strengthened, and churches planted.





Description:

Before churches can make long-term commitments to a particular Unreached People Group or a lost city in the Asia-Pacific Rim, it is critical to come out first and survey the land and meet the people. This one-week pastor/mission leader vision trip will be guided by one of our veteran Connections Team members. This team will be made up of 6 to 8 pastors or mission leaders from our various SBC churches. They will have a chance to prayer-walk these lost cities and people group areas. They will also have the opportunity to meet with various IMB missionaries on the ground who are leading the ministry there and find out how their churches can come alongside and help the missionaries plant indigenous churches in the future. This vision trip will open the eyes of all who attend to the real needs on the ground. Time permitting, this trip will allow pastors and mission leaders to visit at least two capital cities in two countries of the Asia-Pacific Rim region.

In order to raise up the next generation of Christ-followers and kingdom leaders, may these children and teens experience more of what following Jesus means for them and make personal, life-long faith commitments.







Description:

Partner with a local Chinese immigrant church to develop its children's and youth ministries, specifically by starting summer camp programs.

Purpose: Our immediate goal is to help these churches reach and keep their children and youth. Many immigrant churches face huge "second generation" challenges as their children grow up in new home countries with language and culture very different from their parents. As a result, these children struggle to stay connected with church as they grow older and see faith as something for their parents and not themselves. Through intentional ministries like a summer camp, children and youth can not only learn but experience more of what following Jesus means for them and make personal, life-long faith commitments.

Our long-term goal is to mobilize and train these churches to reach other families in their communities and raise up the next generation of Christ-followers and kingdom leaders. Volunteers will work alongside adults from the church, giving opportunities for hands-on learning, encouragement, and inspiration as part of this process.

Volunteers will learn how to use clay pot water filters as a bridge to share the gospel in several village homes each day. Volunteers should be in good physical health, able to sit on the floor for hours at a time, and willing to learn new ways of sharing the gospel with Buddhists.

The team is required to prepare their personal testimonies to share with a group or audience upon request. The blend of both traditional and more contemporary English praise and worship music is preferred. Since the team will be serving in an unfamiliar environment, a positive attitude to handle a new culture and surroundings, along with the flexibility and ability to handle stress well, are required. There will be occasions that the team will be actively engaging with pedestrians, approaching them for help to fill out questionnaires, holding up signs, handing out flyers, etc. The purpose is to help our Japanese partners with the work for the kingdom in promoting events along with other ministries such as English Bible Class. With this, an outgoing/friendly personality and the ability to engage with pedestrians actively and pleasantly on the street are highly preferred.







In this city, you'll see high-rise luxury apartments next to a squatter village, megamalls beside concrete villages, and expressways above thousands of homeless people. You can enjoy a coffee from any number of cafes and sample almost any Asian cuisine to top it off, all the while mingling with some of the nation's three hundred ethnic groups. It is truly a gateway city to the remainder of this Southeast Asian country.

On your trip, you will pray for the city, evangelize the lost, encourage disciples, and strengthen local churches. Our vision for the city is to have the gospel available for every person and healthy churches in every segment of the city.

If you use them, consider adding a simple explanation. Set a goal of 500 characters (Simplified Chinese) for your story. For theological questions, use the Baptist Faith and Message as a guide.

Consider involving your church community! Use this as a way for a small group or Bible study to share their testimonies together. Have everyone in the group write a testimony, share them with the group, and send them for use on the website.

You will live on campus and have the opportunity to build deep relationships with students, many of whom have never had anyone explain the gospel to them. Students will also be tasked with encouraging any believing students at the university in their walk with the Lord and in outreach to the lost.

Description:

We are seeking to engage the Unreached People Groups and the Unengaged Unreached People Groups among the islands where we live with the gospel and help foster a sense of Christian community among new believers through ongoing discipleship. Our national partners do most of the ongoing work of discipleship, but volunteers from the USA help open doors for them among these islands and play a vital part in the process. Regardless of the trip length, volunteers will have opportunities to pray for, interact with and engage unreached and unengaged people with the good news, as well as learn more about ministry in remote island areas. Volunteers can also see the variety of ways we engage the people through businesses, community development, and partnering with like-minded national and international sending organizations. Two examples of our community development work in the island villages include a milk goat farm and the processing and selling of cashew nuts. We have been partnering with churches and seminaries through the Embrace Program and through short-term trips for ten years, and have had hundreds of volunteers visit and take part in the ministry.
